## AMENDED ORDINANCE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MAINTENANCE OF THE WINSTON COUNTY ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM

Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Winston County, Mississippi, by said Board as follows:

## 1. NEW STRUCTURES AND MOBILE HOMES

(a). All persons, firms, corporations, and other legal entities constructing new structures, locating or re-locating mobile homes and changing the location of their physical address (e.g. a renter), in Winston County, Mississippi, shall from and after this date obtain an address notification form, which shall be in the following form:

- b). No utility company operating in Winston County, Mississippi, shall furnish its utility services to any structure (including existing structures) or mobile home, including a mobile home that is moved from one location to another, until it has been furnished with an address notification form duly issued by the Winston County E-911 Coordinator.
- c). Applicants shall apply for and file the Address Notification Form with the Winston County E-911 Coordinator, c/o Winston County E-911, 202 A. South Church Avenue, Louisville, Mississippi, 39339. The E-911 Coordinator shall furnish the applicant with sufficient copies to present to the utility companies and the U. S. Post Office.
- d). Immediately upon the filing of the Address Notification Form, the Winston County E-911 Coordinator shall assign a number and address to the structure. The E-911 Coordinator shall keep a record of all numbers and addresses assigned.

## 2. POSTING OF DESIGNATED HOUSE NUMBERS

The owner of occupant or person in charge of any house, building, mobile home, or other structure to which a number has been assigned:

- a). Shall within thirty (30) days after the receipt of such number affix the number to the structure in a conspicuous manner in a conspicuous place.
- b). Remove any different number which might be mistaken for or confused with the number assigned to said structure by the issuing authority.
- c) . Each principal building or structure shall display the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is located. If the building or structure is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance may display a separate number.
- d). Numerals indicating the official numbers for each principal building, or each front entrance to such building, shall be posted in a manner as to be legible and distinguishable from the street or road on which the property is located, with number painted or applied of not less than THREE inches (3") in height.
- e). Mailboxes shall be marked with the house number.
- f) If the structure is not visible from the street or road on which said structure is located with no mailbox beside the driveway leading to the structure, a sign or number post shall be erected by the owner or occupant to display the number which may be displayed either vertically from the top down or horizontally.

- 3. In the event that the owner or occupant or person in charge of any House or building fails or refuses to comply with the terms of this ordinance by failing to affix the number assigned within thirty (30) days after notification, or fails within said period of thirty (30) days to remove any old numbers affixed to such house, or house entrance, or elsewhere, which may be confused with the official number assigned thereto, he/she shall be punished by paying a fine or not less than \$10.00 for every day that the situation is not rectified.
- 4. This ordinance applies to all structure in Winston County including those lying within the corporate limits of the City of Louisville and the Town of Noxapater.
- 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
- 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- 7. The Clerk of this Board is directed to publish this ordinance in the Winston County Journal one (1) time, to obtain proof of publication thereof and to file said proof in the minutes of this Board, and to provide each public utility company a copy thereof.

Supervisor Lamar Turnipseed seconded the motion of Supervisor Luke Parks, and upon a vote said amended ordinance was adopted as follows, to wit:
