**SUBJECT: Civil Emergency Curfew Proclamation**

Mayor Will Hill and City officials instituted a city-wide curfew that went into effect June 7, starting at 10:00 p.m. and ending daily at 5:00 a.m. for 14 days.

Based upon the information provided by the Louisville Police Department, the curfew will be extended and modified as follows:

- **The curfew is in effect from 11:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. daily**
- The night time curfew applies for all citizens (with the exceptions of emergency personnel and those commuting to and from work, including students traveling to/from classes)
- Drivers or individuals may be stopped by law enforcement and should be prepared with the information. Violation of the curfew is a misdemeanor.

**CURFEW:**

Pursuant the Board of Aldermen authorization in a regularly stated meeting of May 3, 2022, the Mayor hereby imposes an extension of the curfew for 11:00 p.m. in the City of Louisville upon a recommendation by LPD Administration, the order may be issued in 14 day increments and as needed. The Mayor finds that a public emergency has been created as a result of an increase in gun violence and property crimes, creating a serious and substantial menace to the public peace, safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Louisville, Mississippi.

Beginning at 11:00 p.m. on June 22, 2022, this modified curfew takes effect. This curfew will remain in effect until 4:00 a.m. on July 6, 2022, unless rescinded or extended by the order of the Mayor.
