

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR
AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE
HELD ON THE 2ND DAY OF JANUARY 2018**

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Louisville was held at five-thirty o'clock p.m. on the 2nd day of January 2018, at the City Hall, the aforesaid being the time and place for the meeting with the following officers present: Eugene Crosby, Mayor Pro Tem; Frances S. ORDER – APPROVAL OF MINUTES

**ORDER –HEARING ON UNCLEAN PROPERTY
LOCATED AT 124 REED AVENUE**

Ball duly seconded by Frances S. Ball and unanimously approved, the Board determined that property located at 124 Reed Avenue is unclean and adopted a resolution giving the owner thirty days to clean the said property. **ORDER –HEARING ON UNCLEAN PROPERTY
LOCATED AT 111 WEST JEFFERSON STREET**

There came on for consideration the matter of a hearing to determine if certain property owned by Versie Dawkins and located at 111 West Jefferson is unclean or unsafe, then upon motion made by Judy H. McLeod duly seconded by Gwenita Mays and unanimously approved, the Board determined that the property located at 111 West Jefferson Street is unclean and adopted a resolution giving the owner 30 days to clean the said property.
